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Objective of this CME:

To sensitize Health Care Professionals regarding latest GUIDELINES & PROTOCOLS of Medico-legal care for survivors/victims of sexual violence (2013) by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India.

Course highlights:

"Sexual violence, in addition to being a violation of human rights, is an important public health issue as it has several direct and indirect health consequences".

"Survivors of sexual violence may present with varying signs and symptoms without revealing the history of it."

" Treating Physician has the obligatory Responsibility of Providing Medico-legal Care".

"Dual responsibility of health care professional: 1st to provide medical treatment and psychological support. 2nd is to assist survivors in their Medico-legal proceedings by collecting evidences and ensuring a good quality documentation".

"The Criminal Law Amendment Act (2013) in Section 357C CrPC has widened the definition of rape to include all forms of sexual violence and recognises the right to treatment for all survivors, it also says that both private and public health professionals are obliged to provide treatment to the victim. Denial of treatment is punishable under IPC".

"Follow an uniform method of examination and evidence collection by following the MOHFW, protocol. [In Sexual Assault Forensic Evidence (SAFE) kit]".
