10. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview.

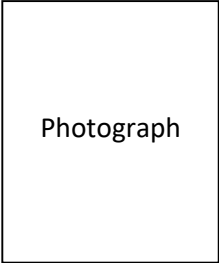
